NOTICE OF APPEAL OF CHANCELLOR'S ORDERS GRANTING INTERVENTION

Appellant, Clata Renee Brewer, respectfully gives notice of her appeal of the Chancellor's two Orders entered Wednesday, May 24, 2023,

granting the Motions to intervene of Covenant Presbyterian Church, The Covenant School, and an unknown set of Covenant School Parents being permitted to appear pseudonymously. These two Orders are final judgments under Tennessee Rule of Civil Procedure 24.05.

The Chancery Court has pending four separate Complaints/ Petitions under the Tennessee Public Records Act, Tenn. Code Ann. § 10-7-503, *et. seq.*, against the Metropolitan Government of Nashville and Davidson County ("Metro"). These all pertain to the murders at The Covenant School in Nashville. The Chancery Court consolidated those four cases under the lowest case number, No. 23-0538-III, the case filed by Plaintiff/Petitioner Brewer.

For purposes of this appeal, the Appellees are Covenant Presbyterian Church, the Covenant School, and the anonymous set of Covenant School Parents. Defendant Metro is not an Appellee, but is a party to these cases.

This appeal is as of right, pursuant to Tenn. R. App. P. 3 and Tenn. R. Civ. P. 24. The Chancellor's Orders granting the motions of three sets of intervenors is a final judgment, entered on May 24, 2023. Appellant asks that the appeal be expedited, given the ongoing and current circumstances surrounding this matter.
